

VOTING RIGHTS

The League of Women Voters of the United States believes that voting is a fundamental citizen right that must be guaranteed. Statement of Position on Citizen's Right to Vote, as Announced by National Board, March 1982. (LWVUS *Impact on Issues*, 2010-2012, p. 13)

Although the right of every citizen to vote has been a basic League principle since its inception, this tenet was made a position following the conscious effort of the League to emphasize the extension of voting rights under the Voting Rights Act of 1965 and its subsequent amendments.
