League of Women Voters of NYS Launches Electronic Voters Guide

The League of Women Voters of New York (League) is pleased to announce the launch of Vote411.org in selected communities throughout New York State.

League President Betsey Swan described VOTE411.org as a "one-stop-shop" for election-related information, providing nonpartisan information to the public with both general and state-specific information on the following aspects of the election process:

- An electronic voters guide with information provided by candidates
- Absentee ballot information
- Ballot proposition information (where applicable)
- Election dates
- ID requirements
- Military and Overseas Voting
- Polling place locations
- Registration deadlines
- Voter qualifications
- Voter registration forms
- Voting machines

It can be accessed **online** through the League's website at www.lwvny.org in an easy-to-use electronic format. Citizens can compare candidate information and print a customized sample ballot prior to election day.

Currently, candidate information is available for Albany, Monroe, Saratoga, Schenectady, and Westchester Counties, as well as New York City and the Hamptons. Information for Broome, Erie, Rensselaer, Tioga and Wayne Counties, as well as for the Huntington area, will be posted as it becomes available.
